



Drop in Child Care

Medical/Health, Safety and Emergency Policies

Emergency Medical Procedures:

If a child should become ill while being cared for by Maui PlayCare parents will be contacted immediately. Sick children will be isolated but remain supervised and made as comfortable as possible. Children should be picked up as soon as possible. If a child becomes seriously injured during their stay, parents will be notified immediately if necessary asked to make any decision as to transfer of their child to a medical clinic.

All Maui PlayCare staff members are CPR, First Aid and First Response certified. All employees have been background checked on a National and Local level. All employees are trained to follow Maui PlayCare procedure for injuries: Maui PlayCare will treat superficial injuries by washing with soap and water and covered with a bandage, and/or treated with ice. Parents will be notified of minor injuries when they pick up their child. In the case of a medical emergency 911 will be called. Should an ambulance be necessary, parents will be responsible for those costs. Parents will be contacted as soon as possible after contacting 911. If possible Maui PlayCare will ask the child be taken to the parent's medical facility of choice.

Any injuries, change of behavior or appearance during a child's stay at Maui PlayCare is documented utilizing our "ouchie reports" and our log book. Parents will be notified when picking up the child.

Health:

For the health of the children and staff in our facility, we only accept healthy children. Maui PlayCare will not administer medications. If your child has experienced any of the following symptoms within 24 hours, please refrain from bringing them to our center:

- Temperature of 100.6 or higher
- Nausea/vomiting/diarrhea
- A contagious disease such as chicken pox, strep throat, or pink eye
- Red, watery eyes with drainage
- Undiagnosed rash
- Phlegm producing cough and/or constant, thick colored nasal discharge

All children must wear socks only while playing in the playroom.

Maui PlayCare follows these guidelines to promote healthy, happy play. We value each and every child and make every effort to ensure a safe, clean, and exciting environment for your children to enjoy!

Emergency Safety Procedures:

In case of an emergency that would require an evacuation from the Maui PlayCare facility, children will be evacuated through the nearest safe exit. If at all possible, the parent sign in sheet with all contact information for that day will be taken to ensure all children are accounted for and parents can be contacted. Children will be assembled in the open parking lot.

In the event a child is not accounted for in an evacuation, police will be contacted immediately.

In the event a lock down is required at the Maui PlayCare center – all children will be held in the back portion of the playroom away from all doors and windows. Parents will be notified of the lockdown and notified again when they are able to pick up their child.

In the event Maui PlayCare loses electricity Maui PlayCare staff will notify all parents within 30 minutes.
